SCHOOL RULES FOR FATIMA CHILDREN.

- Children must always greet adults when they see them.
- Children must close doors behind themselves quietly.
- Children must be early to school
 (8.00am). The school gate will only be
 open from 7.30am. When there are
 members of staff at the gate waiting
 to welcome children to school.

The school gate should be locked unconditionally at 8.15am, and children who are late to school will be barred entry into the premises.

- Children are not allowed to talk while eating.
- Children must not speak out of turn; they
 Must raise their hands up to indicate their
 Interest to speak in class.
- Children must keep the noise level low by

Speaking in good classroom tone.

- Children are not allowed to walk between
 Talking adults or children.
- Children must take turns during play or work activities.
- Children must put their chairs under the
 Table when standing up.
- Children must look after classroom and school property.
- Children are not allowed to run inside the school buildings.

- Children must walk properly with their hands either in front or behind them.
- Children are not allowed to loiter during class hours.
- Children must always take permission from the teacher before they leave their class;
 they must also obtain a hall pass before
 leaving the class.
- Dropping litters around school is not allowed.
- Children must never chew gum at school.

- Children must always pack their homework bags after copying their homework into the homework Notebook/communication
 booklet.
- They must also do their homework by themselves in the comfort of their homes, while parents supervise the homework.
- Homework must be completed and submitted as at when due.
- All children must be dressed to school in a nicely ironed school uniform, clean white

socks on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and
Thursdays/Navy Blue socks on Mondays and
Fridays and well-polished black shoes daily
except on Thursdays- Sportswear and White
Canvass.

Girls should come with nice cornrows, plaits
 or threaded hair. Girls should not wear hair
 extensions/attachments, nail extensions,
 nail polish, make up or jewelry with the
 exception of appropriate earrings.

- Afros are not allowed. Boys should wear low cut hair. Boys should not wear jewelry or hair extensions to school.
- Long finger nails are not allowed. Children must keep their nails short and clean.
- Henna is not allowed.
- The use of personal electronic gadgets, e.g.
 GSM mobile phones, MP3 players, portable
 game console in school is prohibited.

- Children are also not allowed to come to school with fashion accessories, toy or money.
- Party packs are not allowed on birthdays.
 Children may however come along with
 their party dress and bring only birthday
 cake for cutting, cupcakes and non-fizzy,
 non-bottle drinks, which will be shared only
 during break period(9:45am-10am-Early
 Years/ 10:45am-11am Primary)

- Disruptive behavior in class or at assembly is frowned at. Children must always conduct themselves well.
- Fighting is not allowed.
- Children are not allowed to bully other children.
- Children are not allowed to be rude, or interrupt adults talking.
- Children must call attention by saying "excuse me please".
